HVAC:

Electrical - fee type: Generator - \$75; this fee covers one trip; a partial inspection fee * will be applied if multiple trips are involved (this does not include re-inspections). The fee does not include other electrical installations being performed in conjunction with the generator installation (i.e. sub panel, lighting, receptacles, etc). If additional electrical installations are proposed, such installations shall be indicated on the application and fees will be assessed accordingly.

State of Ohio Fee – All fees assessed to permits are subject to a 1% State of Ohio fee.

Fees (Commercial)

Application Fee - \$25

Plan Review - \$75

Gas - fee type: Generator - \$75; this fee covers one trip; a partial inspection fee will be applied if multiple trips are involved (this does not include re-inspections).

Electrical - fee type: Generator - \$100 (permanent), \$75 (portable); this fee covers one trip; a partial inspection fee * will be applied if multiple trips are involved (this does not include re-inspections). The fee does not include other electrical installations being performed in conjunction with the generator installation (i.e. sub panel, lighting, receptacles, etc). If additional electrical installations are proposed, such installations shall be indicated on the application and fees will be assessed accordingly.

State of Ohio Fee – All fees assessed to permits are subject to a 3% State of Ohio fee.

Special Instructions if service is altered:

1) It is very important to coordinate the date and time with the utility company, the Delaware County Department of Building Safety electrical inspector and the contractor performing the work.

2) Call the electrical inspector performing the inspection between 7:45 and 8:15 the morning of the inspection to confirm time.
